

Lagan Valley Vineyard | COVID-19 Youth Policy

Lagan Valley Vineyard is committed to making wise decisions to ensure we minimise the spread of Covid-19. The decisions made by our leadership and staff team are informed and inline with the most up to date government guidelines and legislation. The safety of our young people, volunteers and staff is of utmost importance to us at LVV. Below you will see what you can expect from us and what we can expect from you in order to carry out gathered environments safely.

What you can expect at our LVV Youth & Kids events:

<u>Covid cleaning</u> - All rooms, resources, equipment and surfaces will be cleaned and disinfected before and after every event. This includes: door handles, light switches, chairs, toilets, kitchen space, music stands, microphones, sound desk and games that are used during our duration.

<u>Ventilation - Our space</u> has designed with built in ventilation systems in the Main Auditorium, the small and large kids room, this system is on anytime there are people in the Venue, this system regulates the air constantly, keeping it fresh and clean. The entrance and large foyer are ventilated by the main entrance doors.

<u>Track and trace</u> - All LVV Youth & Kids events will be by registration online and when you arrive you will be checked in by a volunteer. To register for events sign up to our weekly email or go to the events section of our website. (*Please see our Privacy Policy and Data Protection Policy for guidance on storing data*)

<u>Adhering to maximum number of people</u> - Sign up process allows us to keep our events to capacity and remain within the most up to date legal maximum capacity for gatherings.

Furthermore each room will have gone through a Risk Assessment based on the government guidelines.

<u>Social Distancing</u> - For all youth events the venue will follow a strict one way system. Young people and leaders will: *Check-in, Sanitize and be allocated a seat for the event.* Where possible households will be sat together to minimise the amount of households at each station. Leaders will be present at all times to help monitor and guide safe environments for young people and children. All youth events will therefore take part in the main space, as this has the largest capacity and will make social distancing easier.

<u>Communal foods</u> - There will be no communal snacks available to prevent cross contamination. Where snacks are provided leaders will pre-pack these into personal packs (hand hygiene carried out, eg gloves and hand thorough hand-washing).

What we as Lagan Valley Vineyard expect from you:

<u>Symptoms</u> - If you have displayed any symptoms of covid 19 within the past 14 days please refrain from attending youth related events, useless you have tested negative for covid 19. These symptoms include:

- New Continuous cough
- Loss of smell or taste
- A high temperature

<u>Local lockdowns</u> - We ask that you respect local level lockdowns and refrain from attending youth related events if you are living in an area of local lockdown. We encourage you to keep up date with this, as we will also.

Adhere to this Policy - to ensure the safety of all young people, leaders and the wider church family strict adherence to this policy is expected from all young people, leaders and our staff members.
