ROLE DESCRIPTION

About the role

Vineyard Church volunteers are welcoming and committed people who want to help support communities. As a Volunteer Delivery Assistant, you'll be playing a vital part in making sure furniture and household items are delivered to those who are in need. You'll help load a van from our venue and deliver directly to homes with our Volunteer Van Driver, ensuring a prompt, safe, reliable and friendly delivery on one Saturday per month. You will need access to a vehicle and a smart phone to volunteer as you will follow the van to assist with delivery.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Skills you'll learn

- Teamwork: you'll work as part of a team of volunteers ensuring our delivery service can take place. This "Compassion Team" is at the heart of our church family in community.
- Relationship building: you'll be building lasting relationships with your fellow volunteers. And be encouraged in this role to invest in your relationship with Jesus and the Holy Spirit.
- Time management: you will be required to be organised and to deliver on time to homes planned for the day. A typical day is Saturday morning 10am to 2pm.

What to expect from LVV

- Support and advice from our Volunteer Van Driver leading the delivery.
- Encouragement to be a Jesus follower in church community with others.
- Expenses for mileage covered in line with our volunteer policy.
- Impressive skills to add to your CV and a reference if/when you need it.
- The opportunity to make a difference during a challenging time.

What's expected from me

- Have bags of enthusiasm!
- Follow all LVV Safeguarding policies and procedures – including all guidance surrounding coronavirus/general Health and Safety, and the socially distanced delivery process.
- Follow advice/training given by our Volunteer Delivery Driver and LVV Staff.
- Support LVV to fulfil its aim to bring the life of Jesus to every person and every place.
- Keep all data about homes/people secure and confidential.

Whilst Driving your own vehicle (or should we hire a vehicle for you to drive):

- A full and valid UK driving licence.
- A road-worthy vehicle with up-to-date road tax and MOT certificate.
- Fully comprehensive car insurance that declares you are a volunteer with us.
- Read and agreed to Volunteer Drivers Policy.
- A smart phone to follow delivery routes.
- Never use your phone for calls whilst driving as a volunteer

Time commitment

Give as much as you feel! It is easy to volunteer with LVV and for this role we ask for one Saturday per month (Morning) and our next date is 24th July. Onwards dates tbc

Health matters. This role would best suit you if you are physically fit and healthy and we ask that you check any health concerns with your GP by showing them this role description if you are unsure if your health permits you to volunteer, including pregnancy, body mass, back pain or any injury.

COVID Precautions. If you or anyone close to you develops a temperature, loss of smell or taste or a new, continuous cough, we ask you to not volunteer at that time.
